Dr. Weiying Chen is the Vice Dean for International Affairs of the International School of Medicine, Zhejiang University (ZJU-ISM). Since her assumption of the post in January 2022, she has been focused on international issues of strategic, long-term importance to the school and the hospital (ZJU4H). Her goal is to help the school develop strategy and services that facilitate faculty, clinicians and students to carry out dynamic international activities.
