



01 Longitudinal Dual Mentorship

Systematic Anatomy

As the core backbone course of medical education, Systematic Anatomy is a highly popular premium MOOC scoring 4.8/5. Combining clinical cases with medical history, humanitarianism and innovative achievements, this course will cultivate students' learning motivation and further helps them grow into excellent medical experts with an international perspective, benevolence and innovation.

Pathology

As a national brand course approved by MoE, Pathology provides a comprehensive introduction to pathology. It bridges basic sciences and clinical medicine by covering pathogenesis, cells/tissues/organs changes, and their clinical correlations, with two parts: General Pathology and Systemic Pathology. This course enables medical students to properly conduct and interpret basic clinico-pathological procedures for common diseases.

Integrated Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine

The course focuses on resource integration, theory serving practice, and the combination of holistic view and system biology, individualization and precision medicine. Through this course, students will understand the strong vitality and practicality of integrated traditional Chinese and Western medicine, as well as their intersection and development.





Entry Requirements

Applicants shall meet the overall requirements for undergraduate admission of Zhejiang University.

(*The admission requirements are subject to changes in accordance with the requirements of the Ministry of Education.)

01 Eligibility requirements



1.1

Non-Chinese citizen with valid foreign passport

1.2

Under the age of 25

1.3

Have graduated from high school (Graduating students can provide pre-graduation certificates first, then provide the graduation certificates no later than registration.)

02 Minimum entry standards



2.1 Applicants must have passed examination with minimum percentage of marks over 70% aggregate in Math, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (Zoology & Botany) during high school period. (Applicants who don't take one or two required courses in the high school may use their middle school scores as a substitute.)

2.2 Score report of English language Test, e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, CAE, Duolingo or other proof which can reflect applicants' English proficiency.

- IELTS: 6.0 overall or above (academic module) with a minimum of 5.0 in each component.
- TOEFL-iBT: 75 or above with a minimum of 15 in Reading, Listening, Speaking and Writing.
- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English (CAE): 170 or above.
- Duolingo: 100 or above.
- Exemption Requirements (for language proficiency test score report)
 - (1) Native English Speakers.
 - (2) Students holding IB or A-level certificate.

03 Documents for Application



Applicants must log in to the Online Application System for International Students of Zhejiang University, fill in clearly and upload completely the original or notarized scanned copies of the following materials as required.

- 3.1** A photocopy of passport front page. (Note: The passport submitted shall be your most recent one and its expiry date shall be after March 1, 2027.)
- 3.2** Senior high school diploma. Those who provide pre-graduation certificate or student status certificate at application MUST provide senior high school diploma no later than registration.
- 3.3** Academic transcripts for all the courses in senior high school.
- 3.4** Language proficiency certificates.
- 3.5** Personal statement, including study experience, reasons for application and the potential to be a competent physician. (About 800 words)
- 3.6** Two recommendation letters from high school teachers. (Teachers' signature, contact phone number and email address must be on the letter.)
- 3.7** Award-winning Certificates related to academic courses during senior high school period. (If applicable)
- 3.8** Applicants must take China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) on the official website (www.csc.cn) and get the report. Mandatory subjects: Mathematics and Chemistry Optional subject: Physics (Priority will be given to applicants who take Physics assessment.)
- 3.9** Applicants under the age of 18 (by September 1st, 2026) should submit Letter of Guardian Guarantee and the guardian must be an adult living in Chinese mainland. Please note that the minimum age requirement is 17 years old by September 1st, 2026.
- 3.10** Applicants who have given up their original Chinese citizenship and become foreign citizens shall provide the documents required. (see details on the website)
- 3.11** Applicants who have acquired foreign citizenship automatically at the time of birth in a foreign country, whose parents were both Chinese citizens, or one of the parents was a Chinese citizen shall provide the documents required. (see details on the website)
- 3.12** Applicants should complete and hand-sign the downloaded PDF version of Commitments for Zhejiang University Undergraduate application. Applications without the Commitments will not be accepted.

Note:

Once admitted, the passport information cannot be changed until new semester registration. If the passport is replaced due to special circumstances or force majeure, a written explanation should be submitted to the university and consent must be obtained.

Application Process

Online Application

Log in to Online Application System for International Students of Zhejiang University (<https://isinfosys.zju.edu.cn/recruit/login.shtml>), submit all the necessary application documents strictly as required and pay the application fee.

Interview

Eligible applicants will receive an email regarding the method and time of the online interview. Interviews are arranged on a rolling basis.

Check Application Status

Applicants will be enrolled based on academic performance in senior high school, language proficiency and performance in the online interview, etc. Applicants can log in to the Online Application System to track the application status.

Prepaid Tuition(Non-refundable)

Applicants who receive the Pre-Admission Notice should prepay the first-year tuition fee on the Online Application System within the specific time period stated on the Notice. The Pre-admission will be cancelled if applicants fail to prepay the first-year tuition fee within the stated time period.

Preparation for Enrollment

Admission Notice can be downloaded from the Online Application System from the end of June, 2026. Download link of the electronic Confirmation Form for Study in China (for visa) will be sent to the permanent email address filled in the Online Application System by the applicant.
